

Manikya Lal Verma Textile & Engineering College in Bhilwara was an autonomous institution under the Government of Rajasthan until November 1, 2019. It was governed by its own Board of Governors, with the Hon'ble Minister of Technical Education for the Rajasthan Government serving as its president. The board had nine other appointed members including the Finance Secretary, Technical Education Secretary Government of Rajasthan. To date, this board has convened 29 meetings, during which various decisions were made to benefit the institution and its students, particularly concerning rules and policies. The Principal also served as a member secretary of this Board of Governors. Meeting minutes from all sessions were posted on the college's website, distributed to various college departments/sections for necessary actions, and shared with board members for their information.

Currently, the college is a constituent college of Rajasthan Technical University, Kota, and consequently, it adheres to decisions made by the Board of Management of Rajasthan Technical University, Kota.

During the first Board of Governors meeting for the college, it was decided that until the college establishes its own rules, it would follow the Rajasthan Service Rules. These rules are readily accessible to all students and staff through the Rajasthan government's website. The minutes of all subsequent Board of Governors meetings are also uploaded on the college's website for the information of students and staff.

Service records for both current and retired employees are maintained in the Establishment section of the college, accessible to employees at any time. In compliance with state government regulations, essential information such as procurement tenders, faculty recruitment (visiting faculty), student fee payment details, examination form filling instructions, and other educational activities are promptly updated on the college's website.

WhatsApp groups have been established for both staff and students, known as "**MLVTEC Notice Board-2021**" and "**MLVTEC Student Notice**" to disseminate up-to-date information.

All faculty members receive salary and Career Advancement Scheme benefits in accordance with the directives and guidelines issued by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi, and approved by the Government of Rajasthan from time to

time. Additionally, non-teaching and support staff members receive their salaries and other benefits following the Rajasthan government's service rules and notifications.

As per Government of Rajasthan regulations, details about Immovable Property Return are published on the college's website. Currently, information regarding the Immovable Property and annual performance appraisal reports are submitted online and can be accessed on the Government of Rajasthan website.

The college strictly adheres to the academic calendar provided by Rajasthan Technical University, Kota. Any modifications made for the well-being of students and the local administration are communicated to all stakeholders and are considered acceptable. All semester examinations for students are conducted by Rajasthan Technical University, Kota, and degrees are conferred by the same university. Both staff and students diligently follow directives issued by Rajasthan Technical University, Kota, as needed.
