युवा, पठन-संस्कृति और आंतरिक गणराज्य की पुकार

पढ़ने से त्वरित सफलता तक

यदि युवा ए.आई. को सहयोगी बनाए, तो वह विकास का माध्यम बनेगा। यदि उसे “ईश्वर” मान लिया जाए, तो मानव के विलक्षण गुण यथा आत्मनिर्भरता और मौलिकता क्षीण हो सकते हैं।

यहाँ सावधानी आवश्यक है।

श्रीमद्भगवद्गीता का संदेश, अध्याय 6 (आत्मसंयम योग / ध्यान योग), श्लोक 5, आज भी उतना ही प्रासंगिक है—

“उद्धरेदात्मनाऽत्मानं नात्मानमवसादयेत्।” (मनुष्य स्वयं ही अपना उत्थान करे।)

गीता हमें सिखाती है कि—

- आत्म-विश्वास भीतर से जन्म लेता है।
- कर्म की निष्ठा ही स्थायी संतोष देती है।

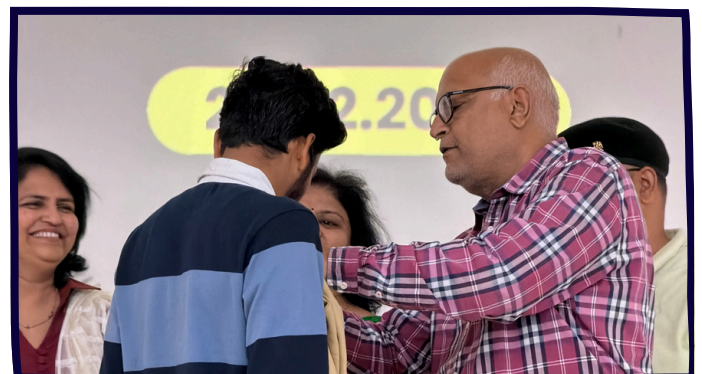
BADGE CEREMONY
