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Budget 2024-25

Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman presented the budget for the financial year 2024-2025 on 1 February 2024 at 11:00 AM at the Lok Sabha.

In this budget, the economic expenditure for FY25 is mentioned along with the seven priority sectors. These 7 priorities or saptarishi are sustainable growth, financial sector, infrastructure and investment, unleash potential, youth power, reach to the last mile, and inclusive development. Here are some key highlights of India's Interim Budget 2024-25:

11.1% increase in capital expenditure: Allocated Rs. 11,11,111 crore, constituting 3.4% of GDP for continued infrastructure development push across highways,

railways, and airports.

Green Hydrogen Mission: Rs. 600 crore allocated to develop this clean energy source.

Support for Key Sectors: PM-KISAN: Direct financial assistance provided to 11.8 crore farmers under this scheme.

Skilling and Education: Focus on training 1.4 crore youth under the Skill India Mission.

Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme: Rs. 6,200 crore allocated to boost manufacturing in key sectors.

Muft Bijli: One crore households to be enabled with rooftop solarization, providing free electricity

up to 300 units per month. Focus on Women Entrepreneurship: Disbursement of 30 crore Mudra Yojana loans to women entrepreneurs.

Tax Proposals: No major changes announced in this interim budget Focus on Women Entrepreneurship: Disbursement of 30 crore Mudra Yojana loans to women entrepreneurs.

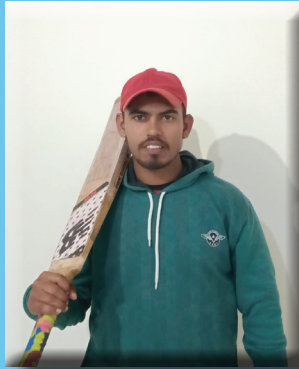
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SAURABH AND ARYAN REPRESENTED RTU KOTA
