


End of Colonial Laws

THREE & HALF DECADES 90URNEY OF MLVTEC

The genesis of MLVTEC lies 35 year back when growing Bhilwara witnessed the inception of a unique degree level institute under the name MLV Textile Institute, Bhilwara offering UG course in Textile Technology in 1988. Approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), it was affiliated to the University of Rajasthan, Jaipur till 2006. At the same time the college was renamed as MLV Textile & Engineering College, Bhilwara.

Beginning of 21st century observed the diversion from a Government funded institution to an institution run in hybrid mode incorporating self-financing UG programs in IT, ECE, and ME and PG in Textiles spanned over the period of time 2001 to 2011.

Experiencing the trails and toils, the institute routed through several milestones reaching to the stature of a research level institute in 2015 and became a constituent college of Rajasthan Technical University, Kota in November 2021 through Government notification.

The inflow of students through JEE has been maintaining the quality and standards of graduation leading to good placement records in a State Engineering college like this where INR 27 Lakh is the all-time high annual package.

Technical Education Quality Improvement Program (TEQIP) – II & III added State of the art infrastructural facilities to the college and industrial support fostered the academics and qualified faculty & staff nurtures the values making its pupils effective human resource for the world of work.



A tribute on 75th Birth Anniversary

In 1988, M. L. V. Government Polytechnic College in Bhilwara transformed and ascended to a degree-level institution and adopted the name M. L. V. Textile Institute, Bhilwara, or MLVTI. This autonomous institute, under the shield of the M. L. V. Textile Institute Society, Bhilwara, gained administrative and financial autonomy from the Technical Education Department of the Government of Rajasthan. However, academic activities remained under the range of the University of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

Born on December 16, 1947, in Bhiwani (Haryana), Sh. S. K. Sharma, a textile post-graduate from the Technological Institute of Textiles, Bhiwani, assumed the role of the first Principal of Manikya Lal Verma Textile Institute, Bhilwara, on August 19, 1989. Despite being physically challenged, he embraced the challenging task of developing the institute by the norms



set by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi, and the regulations of the affiliating University, UoR Jaipur.

Driven by a vision to transform MLVTI into a premier University of Textile, Dr. S. K. Sharma tirelessly worked towards this goal from the day he assumed office. Unfamiliar with the workings of the government system, he quickly adapted, learning the intricacies of file handling, obtaining formal approvals, and issuing orders. As the member secretary of the Governing body, he efficiently presented development plans for necessary approvals. Facing the challenge of establishing an exclusive institution offering an undergraduate course in Textile Technology, he encountered difficulties in recruiting qualified faculty and staff. Despite these challenges, he successfully increased the annual intake and enriched the lab facilities. Dr. Sharma's efforts shaped the institute's infrastructure, a source of pride for the present generation.

By 1993, Dr. Sharma introduced additional undergraduate courses, B.E. (Textile Chemistry) and B.E. (Textile Engineering), responding to the growing needs of the textile industry in Bhilwara. He motivated faculty and staff to enhance their academic qualifications and earned his Ph.D. from M D University Rohatak (Haryana) in 1998. However, despite his hard work and development initiatives, Dr. Sharma faced administrative and procedural shortcomings highlighted during a local body audit. Temporarily relieved of his position, he diligently addressed the objections raised but, unfortunately, could not resume his role as the head of the institution. Eventually, he opted for voluntary retirement following decisions made by higher authorities.

Dr. S. K. Sharma's positivity and resilience defined his tenure as Principal. Despite challenges, he consistently avoided discouraging the MLVTI community, always offering blessings and goodwill. His humility reached extraordinary levels when he extended his blessings even to the person responsible for the tragic loss of his life partner. Such a gracious personality continued contributing to education in Bhilwara until his passing on June 5, 2012, at the age of 64, succumbing to a severe heart attack.

This candid tribute celebrates Prof. (Dr.) S. K. Sharma, an academic and administrative warrior, wishes for his soul to rest in peace while his legacy of positivity continues to guide us in our world of work.


Group Discussion

As he embarks on a new chapter, we express gratitude for his years of hard work and wish him a fulfilling journey exploring new horizons in retirement.






